



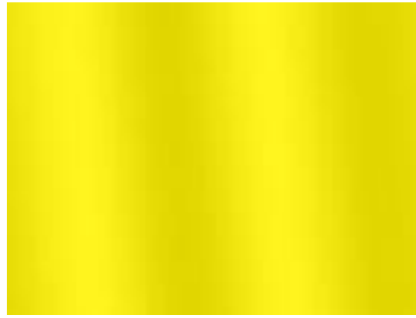
Flags DNKM



All flag signals needs to be followed!

Ignoring and not following risk the safety for all and will be sanctioned in accordance to DNKM regulations by race management

Single yellow flag slewed



- Attention – Danger at track side!
- **Reduce speed substantial**
- Prepared to change driving line
- **NO OVERTAKING!**

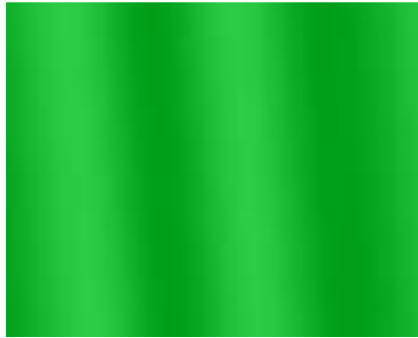
Single yellow flag can be an advance warning for double yellow flag!

Double yellow flag slewed



- Attention – Danger at track or track side!
- Prepared to stop or change the driving line!
- **NO OVERTAKING!**

Green flag slewed



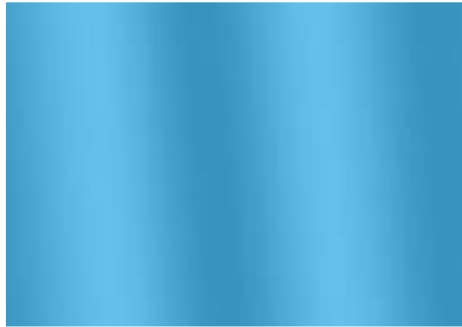
- From this point limitations are reversed

Yellow flag with red stripe



- This flag will only be holded no slewing, it inform that grip at track from that point till next flag piont is worse, oil or liquids... on track.
- This flag will not be reversed by a green flag

Blue flag slewed



- Shows that a faster Kart from another class comes from behind, e.g. start of 2 classes.
- Shows a slower driver that he get lapped.
- Observe track!
- No reduction of speed
- Show by handsignal faster driver on which side he can overtake
- Not blocking others during qualifying to improve starting position, hinder (see guideline)!

White flag



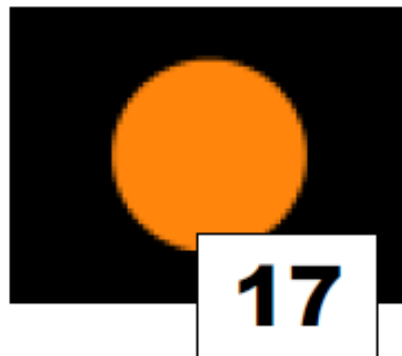
- Shows a slow Kart in front with technical problems or similar
- Reduce speed
- Leave racing line
- **Overtaking is allowed!**

Red flag slewed



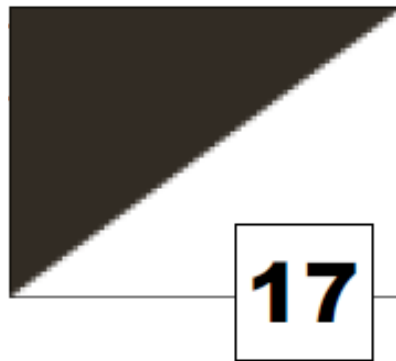
- At once reduce speed
- **NO OVERTAKING!**
- Race or start cancellation
- Following instructions of Marshalls/Race director) respectively return to pit-lane!

Black flag with orange disc (fried egg)



- Flag will shown with starting number, always
- Information for driver that he had a technical problem
- **Nex round to pit-lane!**
- After solving the problem, driver can get back on track

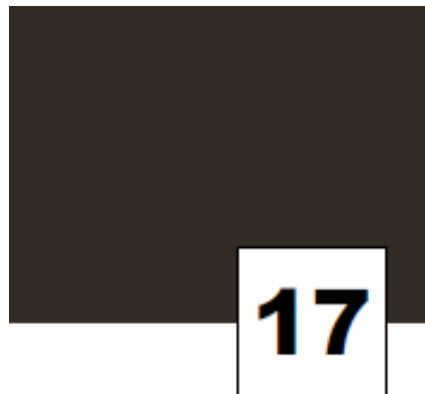
Black and white diagonal sectioned flag



Warning unsportsmanlike!

- Will shown always with a starting number!
- Only once to the affected driver

Blag flag



- Will shown always with starting number!
- **Affected driver has to go to pit-lane next lap**
- **GO to race management!**
